

# Canadian Approvals for Fastfind 210 PLB

Revere Survival Products of Jacksonville, Florida is pleased to announce that the Government of Canada, National Search and Rescue Secretariat (NSS) has approved the Fastfind 210 PLB (Personal Location Beacon) for use in Canada. The Fastfind 210 complies with international standards and operates on the global COSPAS SARSAT 406MHz search and rescue satellite system.

The Fastfind 210 comes equipped with a 50-channel GPS and transmits two signals simultaneously: one to the subscription-free global 406 MHz satellite systems and the other (121.5MHz) is a homing signal designed to facilitate rapid local recovery response. Once activated, Fastfind 210 signals will continue to transmit for a minimum of 24 hours, at a powerful 5 watt output.

The Fastfind 210 is the only PLB on the market today that includes a flashing SOS LED light for night time rescue and weighs only 150g. (5.3oz). Fastfind 210 will operate in temperatures down to -20°C and the battery has a storage life of 5 years. The Fastfind 210 is designed for all outdoor sporting activities. Whether you are boating, biking, hiking or downhill skiing, today's outdoor enthusiasts should never leave home without the Fastfind 210 PLB.
